Wholesale DSL Terms and Conditions

Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) Service

Description

- DSL Service is the regulated provision of fixed broadband data access service Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc.'s local exchange facility.
- DSL service may only be provided to residential and business customers that have an existing Circuit-Switched Voice Service provisioned by Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc.
- The local exchange facility that DSL is provided over includes, but is not limited to:
 - Copper Loops
 - Hybrid copper-fiber loops
 - Fiber-to-the-curb
 - Fiber-to-the-premises
 - Any other wireline technology
 - Fixed Wireless

Regulations

Provision of Service

DSL service is provisioned within Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc.'s FCC designated study area boundary and over Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc.'s existing end user facilities to provide a connection between the Customer's premises and Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc.'s central office.

Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc. will determine the availability and suitability of Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc.'s existing end user facilities to provide DSL Service and will not provision DSL service on facilities that are not suitable for service. DSL service is only available where Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc.'s technical capabilities permit and will not be provided if it will cause interference problems with existing service.

Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc. does not originate data and only provides DSL for purpose of transporting customer- originated data.

Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc. reserves the right to temporarily interrupt DSL service for any reason, including, but not limited to, network maintenance, software updates, and emergencies.

Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc. provisions DSL service on a "best effort" consumer grade basis, and advertised speeds are not guaranteed. The maximum best effort speed that Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc. will provide is 50Mbps or as determined on an individual case basis.

Temporary suspension of service charges is not offered with DSL service and the minimum service period for DSL is one month.

Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc. will only provision DSL Service for the Customer within its regulated service boundary up to and including the end user's Network Interface Device (NID). The Customer is responsible for providing compatible customer premise equipment, installation, and customer service beyond the NID.

Customer Responsibilities

- Provide necessary information for Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc. to provision DSL service.
- Obtain permission from its subscribers for Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc.'s employees or agents to enter the Customer's premises or property at any reasonable hour as needed to provide, terminate, or maintain service.
- Maintain an Acceptable Use Policy with subscribers that forbids illegal use of Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc.'s DSL Services.
- Protect all Customer Proprietary Network Information (CPNI) and comply with all Federal and state CPNI rules and regulations.

Rates and Charges

A Residence Line or Business Line, as specified in Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc.'s local exchange tariff is required for each line equipped with DSL Service. DSL rates and charges are in addition to the rates and charges for any other services Fort Mojave Telecommunications, Inc. provides.
